

Sinus Sufferers: Are you ready for the next step?

SINUS SECOND OPINION

1. Do you suffer with at least three of these problems?

Headache/Facial pressure

Post nasal drip

Nasal congestion

Cough

Phlegm in throat

Fever

Loss of sense of smell &\or taste

2. Have you had these symptoms for more than 3 months?

3. Have you taken more than days 21 days of antibiotics in the past year for upper respiratory infections?

4. Was a CT scan of your sinuses performed? The result showed: Mild sinusitis or moderate to severe sinusitis.

5. Do you have a deviated nasal septum?

6. Have you seen an ENT doctor who specializes in endoscopic sinus surgery, balloon sinuplasty and computer guided surgery?

ANSWER: If you answered 4 of these questions yes, you should seriously consider the sinus surgical options* If you

answered 3 or more of these questions yes you maybe a candidate for sinus drainage*. If you answered only two with a yes, you may require medical treatment only.

***Sinus surgery or drainage can be performed under general, intravenous sedation or local anesthesia depending on which sinuses need to be drained. The type of procedure may vary according to degree of sinus blockage.**

Sinus surgery or drainage procedures include endoscopic sinus surgery, balloon sinuplasty with and without radiation guidance (Acclarent), and office based local anesthesia balloon sinuplasty (Entellius).

Only an experienced trained sinus surgeon can choose which technique is best fitted for the patient.
